(Bonaparte and High Bar).

Based out of the Q'wemtsin Health Society Clinic with outreach one day each week to the communities listed above, you will be supported by Interior Health and the Health Directors of the participating communities.

As the Nurse Practitioner you will be providing full primary care to an established roster of patients along with new patients in need. The goals of this service are to:

- increase the availability and continuity of primary care services for Aboriginal clients
- enhance chronic disease care
- and provide holistic patient centred health care that is delivered in a culturally safe manner.
