- Collaborate with management and members of the provider group to continuously find new ways to enhance the patient experience.
- Assure delivery of clinical services in a way that meets and exceeds quality standards, to promote positive patient outcomes.
- Actively participate and comply with Quality Assurance activities
- Maintain appropriate certification and valid licenses to practice medicine without restrictions.
- Maintain compliance with all CME requirements consistent with the standards set forth by related professional bodies or as imposed by provincial law.
- Build and maintain cross-functional partnerships and working relationships

- Valid Nurse Practitioner license
- Two years of working experience in a clinical setting, including family practice/urgent/emergent care experience with both adult and pediatric populations
- Prior experience working in a fast paced, high growth clinical setting preferred
- Experience working in a variety of the clinical or healthcare delivery environments, and as part of an interdisciplinary team, desired
- Demonstrated effective interpersonal skills including composure, diplomacy, and the ability to interact with a diverse patient population
