Position Summary

A Primary Care Nurse Practitioner opportunity is available targeting services including mental health and substance use, chronic disease management, reproductive health, health prevention and promotion, and education.

Specifically, the Nurse Practitioner, Cariboo Rural, will provide primary care services within the scope of the Nurse Practitioner role to individuals:

- Served by the Three Corners Health Society. This includes members of the Williams Lake Indian Band, Soda Creek Indian Band, and Canoe Creek and Dog Creek Indian Bands.
- Residents in the outlying First Nations communities of Esk-etemec (located in Alkali Lake, BC; approximately 50 km east of Williams Lake) and Canim Lake (approximately 30 km east of 100 Mile House, BC).
- Presently enrolled with Nenqayni Wellness Centre (located in Williams Lake, BC).

Travel is involved to the outlying First Nations communities for clinic work. Days of service provision may change depending on the needs of the specific client population groups.
