

Nurse Practitioner

This Nurse Practitioner role will be involved in maintaining a Chronic Pain Management Program which integrates with private clinics, health authority clinics, the Thompson Region Division of Family Practice, and a local Chronic Pain community-of-practice. This position will be working with a multi-disciplinary team as a member who contributes expertise to the assessment and creation of a common healthcare plan for the patient. When deemed appropriate, the Nurse Practitioner may be the primary follow-up provider for a panel of patients within the tenets of the commonly created healthcare plan.

Working with a team of Family Physicians and Allied Health Care Professionals, the NP will provide continuity of care reducing the need for walk-in clinic visits or sub-acute visits to the Emergency Department. This position offers providing triage and consultative services to patients referred to the clinic as well for their disease management. Patients that 'graduate' from the centre and are better able to self-manage may be attached to the Nurse Practitioner or other Physician practices depending on capacity. With the Family Physician/Nurse Practitioner shared care model, it is expected that the Nurse Practitioner will have 500 to 600 patients attached on his/her roster.
