You must be eligible for registration as a Nurse Practitioner with the College of Registered Nurses of British Columbia (CRNBC) and have recent relevant clinical nursing experience.

*Northern Health gives you the option of completing the OSCE within the first year of employment as a Nurse Practitioner.
