Working within a residential care environment, the NP will provide ongoing primary care services to medically complex adults with substance use and mental health concerns. In coordination with the sessional physician, the NP will be responsible for the comprehensive assessment of patients and clients including diagnosing diseases, disorders and conditions. The NP will initiate treatment including health care management, therapeutic interventions and prescribing medications in accordance with statutory and regulatory standards, limits and conditions, and employer policies and procedures. The NP will provide professional guidance to other staff members in addressing complex care concerns.

This is a part-time position of 15 hours weekly with flexible scheduling.
