The NP will be responsible for maintaining the care of a “panel” of residents as the Most Responsible Provider (MRP) in the assigned homes and will work alongside General Practitioner (GP) colleagues with their own resident caseloads and will share an on-call support system for the care homes. As well there is an opportunity to support care staff at each one of the homes.

Working as a **Nurse Practitioner** you will be responsible and accountable for the comprehensive assessment of patients and clients including diagnosing diseases, disorders and conditions. As a valued member of the team your duties will include initiating treatments including health care management, therapeutic interventions and prescribes medications in accordance with the statutory and regulatory standards, limits and conditions, and employer policies and procedures. You will have the opportunity to provide professional guidance to other health professionals and participate autonomously as a member of the interdisciplinary health teams making referrals to specialist physicians as appropriate.

When you join our multidisciplinary team of professionals, your contribution will be valued, recognized and rewarded. Collaboration with clients and other health professionals gives the **Nurse Practitioner** opportunities to identify and assess trends and patterns that have implications for clients, families and communities; develops and implements population and evidence based strategies to improve health and participate in policy-making activities that influence health services and practices.
