- Possession of a valid driver's license and access to a motor vehicle in good repair for work-related travel is required.

Preferred qualifications:

- ACLS preferred, BCLS optional.
- Recent experience as an NP in a relevant outpatient clinical setting and/or front-line clinical work with preference for those working across the life span and in primary care setting such as Family Medicine, Urgent Care or Out Post setting preferred.
- Completion of one or more of; Emergency Nursing Course, Pediatric Advanced Life Support, Trauma Nurse Core Course or other advanced clinical nursing skills preferred. Additional training in CTAS scoring, EKG, lab and other diagnostic results would be an asset.
- Experience in a wide range of assessment, treatment and therapeutic interventions, health promotion, diagnostic procedures, and follow-up care in the community considered an asset.
